- **Conference and research travel grants** provide financial support to graduate students invited to present papers or posters at professional conferences and to conduct research away from campus.
- **Maternity/paternity leaves and other parental accommodations:** Support and accommodations are available to all graduate students for childbirth, adoption, newborn care, foster care, and acute child health care.
- **Child Care Grant Program:** Grants offset child care expenses for graduate students.
- **Conflict management and grievance procedures:** Conflict management resources and a formal grievance procedure provide third-party support to help graduate students resolve conflicts with faculty members.
- **Student injuries and workers' compensation:** Our robust network of support helps students who are injured – regardless of the circumstances – with academic, health, and financial issues. Workers' compensation is available for funded graduate students injured while performing duties on behalf of Cornell.
- **Health Insurance:** Our platinum-level health insurance is free for students funded on assistantships and fellowships.
- **Dental and vision insurance plans:** Optional plans are available to graduate students.
- **Intellectual property** policies provide licensing services and revenue to inventors, including graduate students.
- **Freebies and discounts** for graduate students are available for entertainment, retail purchases, restaurants, travel, fitness, and more.

Graduate Student Funding (Assistantships and Fellowships)

University Policy 1.3 informs expectations between students and faculty regarding assistantship activities, including limits on the number of hours for some types of assistantships; become familiar with the policy: https://www.dfa.cornell.edu/sites/default/files/policy/vol1_3.pdf In summary, Teaching Assistantship (TA), Research Assistantship (RA), and Graduate Assistantship (GA) duties should average no more than 15 hours per week with no week requiring more than 20 hours. Graduate Research Assistantships (GRA) are appointments focused on thesis/dissertation-related research in which the time spent on research is expected to be significant and is not limited to a certain number of hours.

Employment outside of assistantships or fellowships is limited to a total of eight hours per week for GRAs or five hours per week for GAs, RAs, and TAs.
